#### The Extension Events

In addition to the Core Events IDEA will allow for some Extension Events of different types.

These Extension Events will be organized independently and the responsibility rests with the Individuals, Institutions, Associations, Corporate Bodies etc. concerned.

- Workshops, discussion groups, special interest events : focusing on specific themes.
- Audio / Video and Multi-Media Centers, Internet Café: Especially equipped meeting and presentation rooms allowing for demonstration and examination of all kinds of learning and training materials based on single or multi-media technology. Sponsors may need to inform the organizers in advance about the type of programme and the equipment required.

## **Submission of Abstracts and Proposals**

- Abstracts and proposals should clearly describe the intended presentation.
- Abstracts and proposals should not contain more than 500 words (no tables, charts or graphs) plus title and author's name and address including e-mail.
- The form 'Accompanying Information for Submission of Abstracts or Proposals' should be completed and returned at the same time.
- Submission of abstracts by e-mail is welcome (abstracts only).
- If submitted to the e-mail address the text of the abstract or proposal and all accompanying information should be sent as an attachment.
- If submitted on paper or disk, the text of the abstract or proposal should be preferably sent by post. Submissions should be typed or printed in ink and be clearly readable.
- All submitted abstracts will be referred to the Conference Academic Committee and attributed to the different types of events and presentation at the IDEA Conference.
- > Both hard and soft copies of the abstract and full-length paper should be submitted.
- > Please use only MS WORD. Don't send items in PDF.

All those interested are invited to submit papers, based on theoretical models, comparative studies of cross-institutional and cross-cultural nature related to the main theme and sub-themes of the Conference. Empirical and case studies will receive priority over other descriptive studies. Concrete suggestions for improvements in the existing models, systems and practices, should form an essential part of each presentation.

Paper can be submitted only in ENGLISH. The language of the Conference shall be ENGLISH. Please submit your abstract of the paper in about 500 words to the Conference Secretariat by 31.08.2007 by e-mail: pani\_niranjan@yahoo.co.in or idea@yahoo.co.in. The last date for submission of full length paper (8-10 A4 size page length) is 30.09.2007. The paper should be typed in double space in A4 size paper. The references in the paper should be according to the Chicago Manual for Style and authors are requested to take special care about the quality of the paper to maintain the standards of national conferences. Authors of all papers and abstracts accepted by the Academic Committee of the Conference will be informed by 10.10.2007.
