The meeting of the Academic Council was held under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor, Utkal University. At the outset the Vice-Chancellor welcomed and addressed to the members of the Academic Council. In his introductory address he emphasized on the following.

1. The need for introduction of meaningful, need based, career oriented and professional courses to meet the challenges of globalization and to ensure employment of the students.
2. The need for both quantitative and qualitative improvement in the Ph. D programme of the University and he highlighted that the UGC and Ministry of HRD has been emphasizing on the need for 5 fold increase under Ph.D. Programme.
3. The need to fill up of the vacant teaching posts for improvement of teaching learning ambience of the University.
4. The need for upgrading at least one state University to the status of excellence. He emphasized that Utkal University deserves to be upgraded to a Central University and Utkal University is striving towards attending the excellence status.
